**PRESBYTERIAN WOMEN'S SYMBOL:
ITS MEANING**

Forgiven and freed by grace through faith, the central figure stands in praise. Rooted in faith, the trio of women emerge. The outline of the central figure forms a cross. We are Presbyterian women engrafted in Christ by the power of the Holy Spirit. It is no longer we who live, but Christ who lives in us.

The right figure holds a book to guide her reading, studying, praying, or meditating.

The left figure reaches out to care for others, as she shares, nurtures, and heals. The circle represents the church worldwide where women offer their gifts and talents in the midst of the global community.

The uplifted arms of the central figure reach out to embrace a just peace. The relationship between the three figures depicts lives of wholeness rather than turmoil. The three women have no distinct features. They represent all women. The shapes surrounding them express energy, strength, and openness.

Our name, Presbyterian Women, ties us to our denomination. The Bible resembles the Bible depicted in the PC (USA) Seal.

Guided by the Purpose, Presbyterian Women witnesses to the reality of God's present realm.

BENEVOLENCES (continued)

Birthday Offering This offering recognizes our heritage as we celebrate the birthday of the Presbyterian Women. It is received in the spring and is a tradition. The monies are used to fund predetermined projects selected by the Creative Ministries Offering Committee.

Least Coin After spending time in prayer for reconciliation, justice, and peace, women around the world contribute the least coin of their country as a symbol of that prayer. The “least coins” are contributed annually to a common fund from which grants are made for ecumenical women’s organizations’ concerns and projects. PW contributes monthly to this offering at their Circle meetings.

Other Benevolence Giving:

Harvest/Christmas Bazaar This is the time when we have our “Soup and Pie” luncheon along with sale of Christmas craft items, silent auction, harvest goods, handmade items, bake sale and next to new items. Proceeds are disbursed to various local charitable organizations and to specific church projects.



BENEVOLENCES

Budgeted:

Mission Through the pledges and contributions of the women in our congregation, PW is able to make a yearly pledge that goes toward the worldwide mission support of the Presbyterian Church (USA) through the General Assembly Mission Budget.

Presbytery Fee PW makes a yearly pledge to support the basic operating budget of PW of the Presbytery, Synod and Churchwide levels.

Church Women United (CWU) This is a national organization of all Protestant and Roman Catholic denominations. PW supports CWU both financially and with personal involvement by our members.

Together in Service is the new title for the PW Mission Opportunities program. We sew quilts both for local needs as well as the mission field. Infant supplies are made for Third World Countries. There are opportunities for both local and overseas financial assistance.

Local Mission This money in the budget allow

us to respond to local requests for charitable support as the need arises.

Free-Will Offerings:

Thank Offering This offering is to be received in the fall and is a tradition from the northern church. It is a special offering to recognize God's blessings to us.

Forty percent of this offering will be used to support medical mission throughout the world. The balance of the receipts (60%) will be used to fund new, creative areas of mission, undesignated in advance.
